Application Checklist		
	Completed application (Form A)	
	You must be a member in good standing of a Baptist church, in agreement with the Articles of Faith of ChurchCare, and not affiliated with the National Council of Churches, the National Association of Evangelicals, or any Convention of churches. Each candidate must sign the doctrinal statement and agree with the purpose and mission of ChurchCare. Candidates must be spiritually mature men who are truly born again, having placed their faith in Jesus Christ for salvation; who have been baptized by single immersion.	
	A letter of approval from your local church to certify that you are a member in good and regular standing and that your church approves of your ministry with ChurchCare.	
	Your list of references (Form A – pg 6)	
	Read and Sign the ChurchCare Construction Policy (Form C)	
	A recent photo	
When we have received your completed application, your references will be contacted. After they have responded, our Applications Committee will study your file. If this Committee approves, you will be invited to attend Candidate Class and to meet with our Board. Submission of this application does not guarantee your approval as a Missionary Builder; therefore, applicants are encouraged to continue their present employment until a determination has been made.		
Other Requirements for Approval		
Every	applicant is required to:	
	At the discretion of the director, a work assignment with a Lead Builder may be required.	
	Sign Medical Release (Form D)	
	Sign Indemnification (Form E)	
	Meet with our ChurchCare Board. You will be notified as to the time and place of the meeting.	

Attend Candidate Class. This class is usually held during the last part of August.
Complete a support requirement form. A minimum of 70% of required support is necessary before a builder is allowed to be assigned a building project. Missionary builder's support will vary depending upon age and family status from minimal expenses to full-time salary and support.
Meet these and any other contingencies determined by the Board and to wait for permission from the Director of ChurchCare Construction before you begin work.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Your expenses incurred in order to meet with the Board and Administration and expenses while attending Candidate School (approximately \$100 for books, meals and snacks.) Some housing and meals will be provided during Candidate School. (Let your home church know of these needs and they may help you.)
- 2. Raising support necessary to work as a Missionary Builder by presenting your need to churches and individuals. ChurchCare will assist you as much as possible in getting speaking engagements.
- 3. Your living expenses and travel expenses while on deputation.
